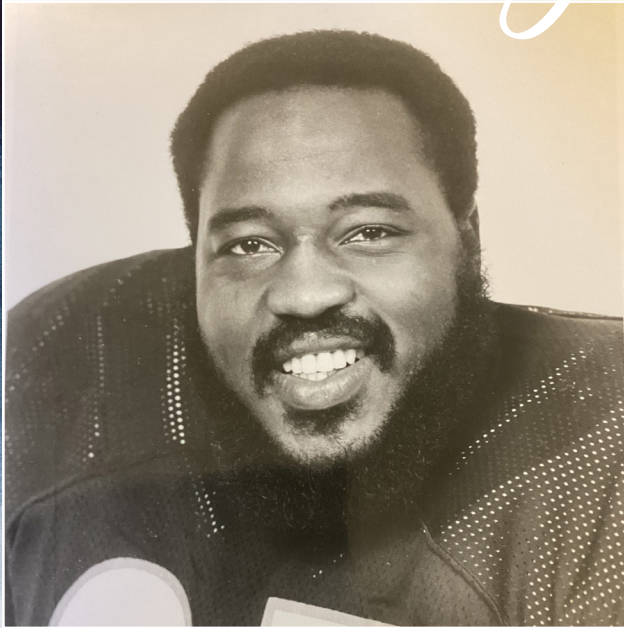

Obituary

Noah Dale Jackson was born April 14, 1951 to George and Lottie Mae Jackson in Jacksonville Beach, FL. Noah attended Duncan Fletcher High School and was a trailblazer in the desegregation of these schools due to his gifted athleticism. While at Fletcher Noah was a dear friend and hero for many. Noah was the Homecoming King (1968) and lead Fletcher's Football team to a successful winning season. Noah also played baseball and basketball.

Noah attended the University of Tampa where he played football from 1969 – 1971. He was later inducted into the University of Tampa Athletic Hall of Fame in 1985. Noah went on to play football for the Toronto Argonauts (Canadian League) from 1972 – 1974. In 1975 he was drafted to the Chicago Bears. He played with the Chicago Bears from 1975 – 1983 and ended his football career with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 1984. While playing with the Bears, Noah received countless awards for both his athleticism and the work he did within the community.

After retiring from the NFL, he worked a variety of jobs as a salesman, electrician and a youth counselor. As a young man, Noah was introduced to his later passion of playing golf by being a caddy. He won countless tournaments across the country.

Noah peacefully transitioned on November 20, 2023 after a lengthy battle with multiple health conditions.

He leaves to cherish his beloved memory his three daughters, Noelle Jackson, Camille Harris (Jermaine), and Monica Applewhite (Darrion). Grandchildren London Harris, Laila Harris, Christian Applewhite, and Cameron Applewhite. Siblings James Buster Jackson (Sylvia) and Carol Kenny Jackson. Dear and loyal friend Isaac Green (Delores), Cousin Robert Hagans (Aletha), and Cousin Catherine Clark (Timothy), Aunt Juanita Hagans, and countless cousins, nieces, nephews, classmates, golf buddies and friends of the NFL.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph Holloway (brother) and Christie McNeil (sister). Noah will always be remembered for his bigger than life personality and presence. We will miss Noah and his memory will live on in the hearts of all those who loved him.
